**To Environmental Education Center:**

Take I-26 to Exit 103 (Harbison Blvd). Turn left at the light onto Harbison Blvd. Proceed until Harbison ends or 't's' with Broad River Road at a stop light. Turn right at the stop light and go through the next traffic light. Almost immediately after going through the light, turn left at the Harbison State Forest sign and onto the forest road.

To reach the Environmental Education Center, continue past the parking lot on your left and head straight (or slightly left) through the gate and onto the gravel road. Take the first right onto another gravel road—there will be a sign for the Environmental Education Center which is located at the top of the hill on the left.
